PROPOSITIONS CA Democratic Party Official Endorsements

PROP 2 - YES

Authorizes bonds for public school and community college facilities

Prop 3 - YES

Constitutional right to marriage

Prop 4 - YES

Authorizes bonds for safe drinking water, wildfire prevention, protecting communities and natural lands from climate risks

Prop 5 - YES

Allows local bonds for affordable housing and public infrastructure with 55% voter approval

Prop 6 - YES

Eliminates constitutional provision allowing involuntary servitude for incarcerated persons

Prop 32 - YES

Raises minimum wage

Prop 33 - YES

Expands local governments' authority to enact rent control on residential property

Prop 34 - NEUTRAL

Restricts spending of prescription drug revenues by certain healthcare providers

Prop 35 - YES

Provides permanent funding for Medi-Cal healthcare services

Prop 36 - NO

Allows felony charges and increases sentences for certain drug and theft crimes
